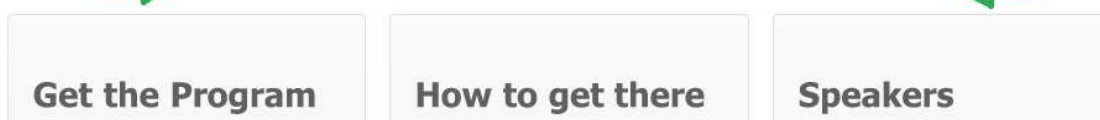

## 2 Browsing ideas list

The visitor can view the title and a short description of the submitted ideas, along with its submission date, author, rating and associated tags and categories. By clicking on any entry under “Ideas by category” (3) or “Idea tags” (4), the visitor can view a similar listing of Ideas under the respective categorization or tagging.

By clicking on the title (1), the visitor gets redirected to the full Idea view page, as seen below.






### 3. Registration and Logging in

Visitors can register by pressing the “Sign up” button and then filling this form, which will open in a pop-up window

- One or more categories out of a list of predefined terms which apply to the idea
- One or more tags, which apply to the idea

and then press “Submit Idea”. The Idea will be posted and be available for reading after approval by the site administrator.
